

## 2012 Macon County Quilt Trail- “Airing of the Quilts” Challenge- Open to all quilters

Quilts may be no larger than 60” total when adding up the length of all 4 sides.  
(Example a 12” x 18” quilt equals 60”, 12+12+18+18)

Quilt may be any technique (pieced, appliqué, embroidery, or a combination of these).

Quilt must use at least one quilt block in overall design that is currently a part of the certified blocks on the Macon County Quilt Trail. More than one block may be used. (See [www.maconcountyquiltrail.org](http://www.maconcountyquiltrail.org) for a list of blocks that may be used.)

Quilts must be turned in on Thursday May 10, 2012 at a location to be announced.  
Judging will take place on Friday May 11 and quilts will hang as part of the “Airing of the Quilts” On Saturday May 12.  
Ribbons will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup>. A grand prize ribbon and cash award will be presented to the overall winner.

Quilts may be picked up between 3:00-4:00 on Saturday on May 12. Quilts not picked up on Saturday may be picked up from Deb’s Cats N Quilts on Monday of the following week.

You may enter up to 3 quilts in this challenge.  
Entry fee is \$8 per entry.
